**COMMUNITY IMAGE ADVISORY BOARD  
RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING TO THE  
MIAMI-DADE BOARD OF COUNTY  
COMMISSIONERS THAT MUNICIPALITIES  
NOT BE ABLE TO OPT OUT OF MIAMI-DADE  
COUNTY'S ZONING REGULATION OF SIGNS**

WHEREAS, it is the mission of the Community Image Advisory Board (CIAB) to implement public projects that enhance the aesthetics of the community, and

WHEREAS, the partners of the CIAB believe that a high aesthetic value in public projects is important to improving the quality of life for residents, increased property values, and fostering repeat tourism to the area, and

WHEREAS, the CIAB is tasked with identifying a County-wide approach to enhancing aesthetic quality across Miami-Dade in collaboration with municipal governments that promotes a world-class image for our community, and


WHEREAS, the CIAB presented the Aesthetics Master Plan to the Board of County Commissioners who adopted it on September 23, 2009, and

WHEREAS, authorizing municipalities to opt out of the County's signage regulations is inconsistent with the Aesthetic Master Plan and weakens the County's ability to develop a seamless baseline for community-wide aesthetic quality

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMUNITY IMAGE ADVISORY BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, recommends to the Board of County Commissioners that municipalities not be able to opt out of the County's zoning regulation of signs.

The Chairperson thereupon declared the resolution duly passed and adopted this June 29, 2011
